In The Know

Week 3: Finance Committee:

The Governance Board manages the church money, creating a budget, oversees income and expenses, establishes financial policies and safeguards the funds to support the LUMC mission. They also manage Stewardship and Designated Gifts given to the church.

Church Goals:

Short term:

- 1 We will advertise and support the events of all five churches now in our Cooperative Parish.
- 2 We will support our youth with leadership and opportunities

Long term:

- 3 We will raise funds to replace the roof of the main church building.
- 4 We will raise funds to add a handicapped accessible restroom on the same floor as the sanctuary.

The Governance Board is moving forward with Goal #4.

The restroom would go into the office off the overflow.

We are looking at two options: 1. For us to do some of the work and have Shrock finish the project. 2. To have Shrock do the entire project. Our initial quote was approx. \$35,000. We have a grant for \$8,000 toward this project, with the need to have it finished by October 2026. If you are interested in helping fund this project, please mark your envelope as such.
